The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 45.7 in the identified area, compared to 62.6 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 62.5% of the 43,349 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 28.5%, renter occupied; and 9.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 42,710 housing units in the area - 64.4% owner occupied, 26.0% renter occupied, and 9.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.66%. Median home value in the area is \$137,928, compared to a median home value of \$190,791 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.88% annually to \$175,020.
